As a sysadmin, I keep things running as smoothly as possible while at the same time being the go-to problem solver for my coworkers. Our small company has a Windows environment (administered through Active Directory) though I've also setup some Linux virtual machines for specific tasks (mainly Debian or Ubuntu Server). These include infrastructure monitoring with Zabbix, our authoritative DNS server running BIND, a few webservers, etc. I've setup numerous Windows servers, including installing and migrating to newer versions of Exchange. In the past I also setup a couple of Windows servers on AWS (EC2) for running a custom CMS (developed by a third-party).

I highly value and very much enjoy learning new skills, both for professional development as well as for personal satisfaction. I dove into Linux around fifteen years ago, dual and triple-booting different distributions. I taught myself some shell scripting and later on some Python programming, at the same time teaching myself to use Git (I also wrote a few scripts in PowerShell). I have a simple static website (forstneric.org) at AWS Amplify (connected to a private GitHub repo), just to see how Amplify works. I do video editing, I've done audio recording and editing, screen-casting, voice-over work and photography.

I also like staying organized, both at work and in my personal life. I use an app called Notion for all of my personal documentation and project management (including to-do's, Gantt charts and kanban boards), having previously tried other apps and services. Form my personal IT documentation and notes, I run a private DocuWiki on a Linode VM.

# Systems Administrator at Mladina, d.d., Ljubljana

January 2011 — Present

I am the sysadmin for the publishing company of Mladina, d.d. The company publishes three monthly magazines (the tech/computer magazine Monitor, the public interest magazine Global and health magazine Zakladnica Zdravja) and the weekly political magazine Mladina. It's a small company (around 30 employees), being a sysadmin means I take care of pretty much everything computer related.

We have a few different servers, mostly Windows servers, a few Linux ones. We run on-premise Exchange and Active Directory, a couple of webservers and an on-premise DNS (on Linux) which is authoritative for our domains. Most of our servers are virtual, running on VmWare ESXi on three physical machines, I use Zabbix (on a Linux virtual machine) for monitoring of our sistems. I do user support, setup laptops, desktops and smartphones and take care of various trouble-shooting tasks. I also take care of communication with a few companies which we contract with - developers of our website and our couple of smartphone apps, for instance.
